2009 Bulldawg Bonanza Goat Shows

Rules and Regulations

1. This show is open to all 4-H and FFA members who are between entering the First grade and entering the 12th grade and not over the age of 19.
2. Certificates of veterinary inspection are required and must state that the animals are “free from foot rot, scabies contagious exthyma, cutaneous fungal disease.” All does must have a USDA scrapie tag.
3. All animals, wether, ewe or does, will be shown as market animals and slick shorn. All animals must be bedded in the show barn. Pens will not be altered (i.e. no wind tunnels).
4. Pre-registered entries will be \$10 per head per show. All entries postmarked after **August 1st, 2009** will be considered late entries and will be charged a late fee of \$20 per head.
5. Goat showmanship exhibitors will show in individual classes as 12th grade through 1st grade and preschoolers. Class will be determined by the grade the exhibitor will be in this fall.
6. After the goat leaves the scales, there will be no re-weighs. There will be no weight cards or weigh backs. Please verify weight before leaving the scales.
7. Goats will be weighed between 6:30 am and 9:00 am on Sunday, August 23rd
8. Only registered exhibitors actively showing and show officials will be allowed in the show arena, except in the preschool showmanship class.
9. Exhibitors must show their own animals unless otherwise approved by the Show Committee. If an exhibitor has 2 animals in one class, another 2009 Bull Dog Bonanza exhibitor may show one of the animals.
10. A preschool showmanship class will follow 1st grade goat showmanship. Preschool exhibitors may borrow any goat for the showmanship competition.
11. **T-Shirt orders for the Bulldawg Bonanza must be ordered when entries are submitted. Free T-Shirts will not be given to everyone entering since \$ 8 of the entry fee will be paid back to exhibitors.**
12. The Bull Dog Bonanza Show Committee reserves the right to review these rules and make changes if necessary. All decisions made by the Show Committee are final.
